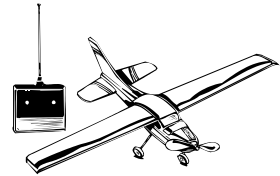

The *Monroe County Radio Control Club* is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to the enjoyment, education, and promotion of the radio-controlled model aircraft sport/hobby.

Our monthly business meetings are held on the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m., at Clariti Advanced Vision Correction, 481 S. Landmark Ave., Bloomington, Indiana. During the summer months, June thru September (weather permitting), our meetings are held at the club flying site on Wylie Road.

We lease several acres north of Bloomington, Indiana, where we maintain a grass runway, a pit area, an open shelter, ample parking, and a rented port-o-jon. This flying site is located one mile east of State Road 37 on Wylie Road (Wylie Road is located 4.7 miles north of the SR 37/46 junction at Bloomington and 11.7 miles south of the SR 37/39 junction at Martinsville).

Our club currently has approximately eighty members. The flying site is used year-round by members and guests. Other pilots and spectators from around the state and elsewhere visit our site to enjoy several events during the year including our annual public air show in September. This helps us to promote our sport and to raise money to support local charities.

We offer free R/C flight instruction by qualified club instructors. In addition to our regular instructors, these MCRCC Intro-Pilots are authorized to help you for a 60-day period to get you started before you become a member:
