If you feel you need a spotter or just want one for any reason, just ask somebody else to come out & spot for you. Most people will be more than willing to assist you.

Michael Friesel did a real nice job of laminating & posting the club bylaws & the AMA rules at the club field. Please don't stick any tacks or pins into them! It will let water under the lamination & destroy his work. All the rules & statements are equally important & we don't need to highlight anything. 

Make sure everyone on the flight line knows U are coming out.

Use the rudder! Fly the pattern.

Call your landings. Use the rudder again!
Holler when you're clear. Check your battery again!
