There is some disturbing news concerning Spektrum receivers & swap meets. It seems that there are some counterfeit receivers out there that look identical to the real thing. Steve Dorsett sent his transmitter & a receiver in to the Horizon

Service center after his heli went into idle-up mode a couple of times without his permission. They informed him that the transmitter was fine but his receiver was a knock-off made to look like a genuine Spektrum.

Not long after Steve's discovery, Mark Sexton had an electric heli jump into a full power/no control situation in the Paragon gym. He hasn't had word yet from Horizon but we suspect the same problem.

I guess the lesson is buyer beware! If the price sounds too good to be true, it's probably not the genuine article.

If we find out how to tell the good

from the bad I'll print it in the newsletter & try to make sure word gets around.

In the meantime, please check your fail-safe settings. Power—up your aircraft with someone safely holding it & shut off the transmitter with the throttle up & be sure that the engine or electric motor **stops** when the radio signal is lost. If it doesn't, don't fly it!

We're still flying in the Paragon school gym on Friday evenings from 6 to 8 & at the West Middle gym in Martinsville from 9 to 1 on Sundays. If you haven't had a chance to join us yet there's plenty of Winter left to get yourself a micro electric & get in on some of the fun. A new device is coming from Hobbico soon that will enable us to operate the Flyzone micros with our computer transmitters & promises to be pretty popular. It's called Anylink & isn't available yet but should be out anytime now.

If you haven't reserved your tables for the club swap meet on February 26th you better do it now before they are gone! Tim Mellott says they are going fast.

Don't give up hope if Santa brought you a new pair of landing gear skis for Christmas & there hasn't been any snow. It's only the end of January. We're got plenty of Winter left to get back to average.
