Proposed amendment to the Monroe County RC Club Constitution - As discussed in the May and June meetings, the following text is being submitted as a new amendment to the Constitution in Article VII paragraph 5. A vote will be taken on this amendment by the club members at the July 9<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Any motion/proposal involving club assets (flying field, club shelter, and holdings) will be published in the club newsletter prior to a club members' vote (giving members notice of the motion/proposal and upcoming vote). Payments for normal business expenditures are excluded from this amendment. In the event of an emergency, the Executive Board may choose to override this statute by a unanimous favorable vote.
