### February Meeting Notes...

It was dark, snowing, & thirty-two degrees outside when the February 8th meeting of the Monroe County R/C Club was called to order in Dr. Matt's warm office at 7:06:13 with twenty-two members in attendance.

Tim Mellott reported that sixteen tables had been reserved for the February 26th swap meet. Volunteers should meet at the Bloomington Cracker Barrel for breakfast at 6:00 A.M. and plan to be at the fairgrounds by 7:00 A.M. to set up tables in the building.

A discussion was started about extending the geomat area of the runway at the club

field from it's current length of 150 feet to 300 feet. If you are interested in campaigning for the cause &/or making a monetary donation, contact a club officer or Mark Claerbout. It's estimated that the project would cost about 800 bucks.

following it every time you fly. Following your check-list can catch many of the stupid mistakes that we have all made at one time or another & save an aircraft as well as making it safer for everyone.
