



## March 2023 Edition

The February 8th meeting of the Monroe County R/C Club was called to order at 7:01:17 in Dr. Matt's Clariti office by president Mark Sexton. It was rainy, windy, & around 50 degrees outside when eighteen club members & one guest (Randy Higgins) made their way in according to counter Tim 2 Mellott.

The first order of business was the club's annual swap meet coming up on March 4th. Tim 2 reported that the AMA got our ad into Model Aviation Magazine and that fifteen tables have been reserved so far. Club members will meet at the Cloverleaf for breakfast at 6:00 A.M. then dash over to the fairgrounds at 7:00 A.M. to set up the tables. The Cloverleaf is on the South West corner of 3rd Street (Whitehall Pike / SR 48) & Curry Pike. Don't forget that those tables have to be taken back down after the event before we can go out for lunch.

Final orders were taken for the annual bulk fuel order that should be available at the April 12th club meeting.

Nothing new was reported in the world of FAA regulations. They are running behind on registering authorized flying sites but still plan to have the new rules concerning model airplanes in place this Fall.

Several dates for flying events this season were announced. The 2023 "Charlie Built" fly-in will be held at Nebo Field in Martinsville on June 17th.
